Make Energy Efficiency Improvements to Your Home. A great way to cut energy costs and save up to \$1,500 in federal income taxes this year is to make energy efficiency improvements to your principal residence. Basically, if you install energy efficient insulation, windows, doors, roofs, heat pumps, hot water heaters or boilers, or advanced main air circulating fans to your home during 2009 or 2010, you may be entitled to a tax credit of 30% of the purchase price, up to a maximum credit of \$1,500. This credit is available even if you received the full \$500 lifetime residential energy credit for 2006 and 2007.
